





Details of Admissions Exercises

JIE 'N'/JIE 'E' – Joint Intake Exercise

The JIE 'N' is for 2-year *Nitec* or 3-year *Higher Nitec* courses offered by ITE. The JIE 'E' is for GCE N(T) students to apply for the 3-year *Nitec* course with Enhanced *Nitec* Foundation Programme.

Details of Admissions Exercises

PFP – Polytechnic Foundation Programme

PFP is a one-year programme that offers a practice-oriented curriculum taught by polytechnic lecturers to better prepare polytechnic-bound Secondary 4 N(A) students for entry into selected polytechnic diploma courses. PFP students are given provisional places in diploma programmes, subject to them passing modules in the all one-year programme.

DPP – Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme

DPP allows Secondary 4N(A) students to be admitted directly into selected 2-year Higher Nitec programmes at ITE without having to sit for the O-Level examinations or undergo a Nitec DPP programme. students who successfully complete their Higher Nitec courses at ITE and attain the required qualifying Grade Point Average (GPA) scores are guaranteed a place in a polytechnic diploma course mapped to their Higher Nitec course.

NFP is a one-year practice-based programme that prepares N(A) Level holders to pursue a diploma in the creative arts. NFP students who successfully complete the programme will be offered a place in their chosen diploma course at NAFA.





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Progression to Sec 5

Some Actual Statistics to Guide You in Making Your Choice

- Students with <u>poorer ELMAB3</u> in N Levels tend to also achieve <u>poorer ELB4</u> in the O Levels.
- There are exceptions, of course.
- Important to make your choices wisely.



Progression to Sec 5

All Sec 4N(A) students who do not have a confirmed place in the DPP or *Nitec* programme at ITE, but are eligible for progression to Sec 5, should report to school on <u>2 January 2025 (Thursday)</u> to continue with Sec 5.

This **includes** students who are eligible for, and intend to apply for the PFP, as <u>eligibility does not guarantee</u> <u>placement</u> into a PFP course. Following the release of PFP application results, all PFP-bound students will be required to attend classes up till <u>31 January 2025</u>.

- 2025 Sec 5N(A) Class List would be disseminated through Parents Gateway by Friday, 27 Dec 2024.
- You can collect the book list from the General Office. Book list will also be sent through Parents Gateway.

8 Things You Should Know Before You Enrol in A Private School

EduTrust Status



School Registration

Ensure the school is registered with CPE. Review the school's registration period, expiry date and its overall registration track record.

Pertnership Pertnership Res the quo

Partner Institution

Research on the partner institution conferring the diploma or degree, and whether the qualification is recognised by the industry.

EduTrust Certification Scheme

Is the school EduTrust-certified"? Under the scheme, private schools are assessed for their performance in areas such as school management and provision of student support services.



School Premises

Head down to the campus ground to check the facilities and support services. Observe the study environment too.

Fee Protection



Ask if there is any course fee protection so that you will be able to recover unconsumed course fees should the school close down.

Beyond Course fees

Find out about the course syllabus and materials, graduation rates and employment prospects. Approach the alumni to find out what they think of the school.

Internship

If industry attachment is included, find out which organisation you will be attached to, the period of attachment and the alternative arrangement should the attachment become unavailable. Verify the information with the organisation as well.





Teachers

Check if the teachers are qualified to teach the course.





- 'Repeat' means
 - Eligible to repeat Sec 4N(A) or
 - Eligible to apply for ITE Nitec courses (RECOMMENDED)
- 'ITE' means
 - Eligible to apply for Nitec courses
