- for class/CCA/school or, on a platform external to school.

AND/OR

Students who have participated in competitions and/or other opportunities pertaining to digital media

# Talents in *Digital Media*

## DEVELOPMENTAL OPPORTUNITIES

Students who accept DSA offers through Digital Media

- must participate in the **Digital Media Club** and/or **English Literary Drama and Debate Society (ELDDS)** CCAs for the duration of their secondary school education,
- will participate in the school's distinctive **Applied Learning Programme (ALP)**, and
- will participate in **talent development programmes** and showcase their talents in these areas
  - Journalism,
  - Digital Media,
  - Digital/AI Literacy, and/or
  - Cyberwellness

## SELECTION CRITERIA

- (A) School reports
  - Academic and CCA records
- (B) Records of involvement in relevant activities
- (C) Submission of relevant artefact(s)
  - Such as
    - 1 article, or
    - 3-5 photographs, or
    - 1 video production, or
    - any relevant portfolio.

## SELECTION PROCESS

Shortlisted applicants will go through an **individual interview** where they will:

- Share their digital media experience
- Answer scenario-based questions

- may choose **any CCA** in Sec 1 upon acceptance,
- will participate in the school's distinctive **Applied Learning Programme (ALP)**, and
- must participate in **CL/ML Tier 3 talent development programmes** which include opportunities to showcase talent on various platforms.

## SELECTION CRITERIA

- (A) School reports  
Academic and CCA records
- (B) Records of involvement in relevant activities
- (C) Marked assignment  
Submission of 1 written assignment completed in Primary 6 that has been marked by their primary school teacher

## SELECTION PROCESS

Shortlisted applicants will go through an **individual interview** where they will:

1. answer a scenario-based question, and
2. deliver a 1-minute impromptu speech.

# Talents in *Languages*

## Bilingualism

Bilingual communication in English Language (EL) and Chinese/Malay Language (CL/ML)

### DEVELOPMENTAL OPPORTUNITIES

Students who accept DSA offers through Bilingualism

- must indicate **English Literary Drama and Debate Society (ELDDS)** and/or **Digital Media Club** as one of their CCA options in Sec 1,
- will participate in the school's distinctive **Applied Learning Programme (ALP)**, and
- must participate in **EL and CL/ML Tier 3 talent development programmes** which include opportunities to showcase talent on various platforms.

### SELECTION CRITERIA

- (A) School reports  
Academic and CCA records
- (B) Records of involvement in relevant activities
- (C) Marked assignment  
Submission of 2 written assignments (one in English, one in Chinese/Malay) completed in Primary 6 that have been marked by their primary school teachers

### SELECTION PROCESS

Shortlisted applicants will go through an **individual interview** where they will:

1. answer a scenario-based question, and
2. deliver a 1-minute impromptu speech in **at least two different languages**.

# Leadership



## WHO CAN APPLY

Applicants who are currently

- School Student Leaders
- CCA Heads / Vice-Heads
- Class Chairpersons / Vice Chairpersons
- Students with other equivalent leadership roles

# Talents in *Leadership*

## DEVELOPMENTAL OPPORTUNITIES

Students who accept DSA offers through Leadership

- must indicate at least one **Uniformed Group** as one of their CCA options in Sec 1.
- will participate in the school's **Learning for Life Programme (LLP)**, and
- will be able to apply for leadership roles within their classes, CCAs and at wider school levels, such as
  - Class Committee Members
  - Peer Support Leaders
  - CCA Leaders
  - House Captains
  - Junior Prefects
  - Prefectorial Board and CCA Executive Committees

## SELECTION CRITERIA

- (A) School reports  
Academic and CCA records
- (B) Records of involvement in relevant activities

## SELECTION PROCESS

Shortlisted applicants will go through a **group situational test**, followed by a **group interview** if further progressed.

# Talents in Sports

- must participate in their **respective sports CCAs** for the duration of their secondary school education,
- will participate in the school's **Learning for Life Programme (LLP)**, and
- will further develop their **skills, character and values through leadership opportunities** within their CCA.

## SELECTION CRITERIA

- (A) School reports  
Academic, NAPFA and/or CCA records

## SELECTION PROCESS

Shortlisted applicants will:

1. go through an **individual interview** to assess applicant's attitude, motivation and leadership qualities, and
2. participate in a **physical test** (can be general or related to specific sports) and Skills test (sports specific).
